## **Revisiting the Christmas Conference**

## A Retreat Template / chb

The event is designed to 'walk' through the entire Christmas Conference at the points where Rudolf Steiner spoke. Other speakers have been omitted to enable the time-frame to become manageable. Likewise, the event will not include commentary made by others at the time or since. The idea is to create a meditative retreat and to do a karmic deed without politics commemorating the moment when the gods accepted Rudolf Steiner's Deed.

In order to ensure a clear will towards the event and to make effective practical arrangements, participation is open to any member of the Anthroposophical Society on condition that they attend all sessions and complete registration seven days prior to the event beginning.

Participants will be expected to have familiarized themselves with the *Proceedings of the Christmas Conference*<sup>1</sup>, including the *World History* course<sup>2</sup>, and to be prepared to contribute to the readings and to the replication of Rudolf Steiner's drawings. A blackboard is needed for replicating the drawings and where possible, space will be found for eurythmy.
